Ryan shared an online only course (Online Assessments) with three components: instructional videos with creation of assessment, assessment and data collection within classroom, and reflection on learning. This course requires teachers to implement a plan within their classroom.

We will pilot two courses in the fall with differing formats, with a limit of 30 participants in each course. Ryan will be able to count the two workshops he's teaching as part of his four workshops. He will be paid two hours of prep for each course.
