3rd Quarter

Iowa State-wide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP): This coming Monday and Tuesday.

On Monday, April 5 and Tuesday, April 6, LMHS Grades 9, 10, and 11, will be taking the Iowa State-wide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP). Students will need their school-issued computers for all exams. PLEASE MAKE YOU'RE YOUR COMPUTER IS FULLY CHARGED PRIOR TO TAKING THE ISASP EACH DAY. Students with accommodations for the exams will have a separate schedule that will be sent separately to each student taking exams with accommodations. Please note that when exam times have ended on April 5, students are done for the day. Grade 12 will be

accommodations. Please note that when exam times have ended on April 5, students are done for the day. Grade 12 will be dismissed at 12:00 p.m. on April 5 until 1:00 p.m. on April 6.

Both April 5 and April 6 will be Group 'A' days. This is because the morning of April 5 and the afternoon of April 6 will comprise one school day of classes. **Group 'B' students will also be onsite for ISASP exams.** Online-Only students have been assigned testing seats based on parent request for either April 5-6 or April 9.

Online-Only Student Computer Updates Required Prior to ISASP:

Online-Only Students will need to do updates on your school-issued computer prior to taking the ISASP. You can either come to exams at least 45 minutes early to ensure updates are completed before the exam before your exams OR stop on campus to log on before April 5 or April 9, whichever date you will begin the ISASP, to have the updates completed.

4th Quarter

<u>Unless requested, students will maintain their current designation as either Online-Only, Hybrid, or Every Day for 4th Quarter.</u>

Process for Opting to Come to School Every Day for the Start of 4th Quarter and at Any Time During 4th Quarter:

Students wishing to start Every Day attendance for 4th Quarter may do so by having parents contact either the 9th-10th Grades Office (447-4043, 447-3050), 11th-12th Grades Office (447-3070, 447-3046), or the Main Office (447-3040) between now and the end of the day on April 9. At any time during 4th Quarter that a student wishes to start attending Every Day, they may do so by having parents let the 9th-10th Grades Office, 11th-12th Grades Office, or the Main Office know by 1:00 p.m. the day prior to returning Every Day so that teachers can be made aware and will be expecting your student.

The process for students wishing to go to Online-Only has not changed. Parents will need to notify Associate Superintendent Nathan Wear (Nathan.wear@linnmar.k12.ia.us) for any student to change to Online-Only.

The 1st Day of 4th Quarter, Monday, April 12, will be a Hybrid 'B' day.

LMHS 4th Quarter Hybrid Schedule:

The current LMHS 3rd Quarter Hybrid Schedule will be maintained during 4th Quarter. Starting April 12, we will simply refer to this as the LMHS 4th Quarter Hybrid Schedule.

Linn-Mar High School Hybrid Daily Schedule for 3rd and 4th Quarter 2020-21

A reminder to students that RTI2 and RTI3 can be mandated by teacher request. If you are requested to RTI2 or RTI3 you are expected to attend the session for that given day. Students may also choose to attend any RTI session on any day.

Changes in CDC Guidance in Classroom Settings:

Many of you are aware that the CDC has adjusted guidance for schools concerning distancing within the classroom setting. The new guidance **allows for 3' between student seating in a classroom** (this has been 6'). At this time, our intention will be to make adjustments within classrooms as needed, from 6' to 3', starting in 4th Quarter (April 12). (We will maintain the maximum distance within the classroom unless student numbers dictate a need to lower the distance to no less than 3'). This is *only in the classroom setting* and all other precautions will remain in place, including mask wearing at all times and social distancing in all other areas of the school building (e.g. commons areas, cafeteria).

Information Regarding 4th Quarter:

- a. The current daily schedule (used for 2nd and 3rd Quarter) will be used for all of 4th Quarter. This maintains the two RTI sessions (11:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.).
- b. Campus Release (with parent approval) will continue during 4th Quarter so that students only have to be on campus during class time. We anticipate this also helping minimize the number of students during lunch hour which makes social distancing easier to maintain.
- c. Current Parking will remain the same at the start of 4th Quarter. We will monitor parking closely. Should numbers of students coming Every Day increase dramatically, we may implement more restrictions.

Campus Release Reminders for 2nd Semester/3rd and 4th Quarter:

- 9th-10th Grade students with campus release may leave the building during periods/blocks with no scheduled class (schedule says "Campus Release"), RTI (if not requested), and during lunch.
- 9th-10th Grade students who choose to stay during your Campus Release period must report to the Learning Center (cannot be in the commons areas). 9th-10th Grade students who are not requested by a teacher yet choose to stay for RTI (always encouraged) must report to your 2nd block/4th period class for the morning RTI session and to your 4th block/8th period class for the afternoon RTI session.
- 9th-10th Grade students choose to stay for lunch may only go to assigned lunch period. Students must then report to the 2nd block/4th period classroom or to the Learning Center opposite their lunch period.
