Planning for Monday, February 15:

As of Noon today, these are our LMHS numbers for Monday, February 15:

Total Students: 2117 (does NOT include the COMPASS Center nor Early Graduates) Onsite Everyday (752), Hybrid (796), Online-Only (511), No Response (60)

12th Grade: Onsite Everyday (142), Hybrid (199), Online-Only (133), No Response (7) 11th Grade: Onsite Everyday (187), Hybrid (174), Online-Only (130), No Response (23) 10th Grade: Onsite Everyday (210), Hybrid (196), Online-Only (126), No Response (17) 9th Grade: Onsite Everyday (213), Hybrid (225), Online-Only (122), No Response (13)

At this time, our max. number of students in the building at any one time looks to be in the 1150 range. This will vary as we get the final 'No Response' declarations and because the Hybrid total does not split evenly by alphabet (A-K, L-Z). We are currently working to determine classrooms which may need to either be moved or bring in barriers to help in mitigation efforts. We will work to make needed adjustments so that classroom settings are safe for students and staff. Several factors (classroom size, class enrollment) will also play a role in making adjustments as necessary. We were hoping the max. number of students in the building each day would be less than 1200, which it currently is. We believe that we can make this work with some adjustments. If the number was closer to 1500, the task would have been much more challenging.

A few determinations have been made for all of 3rd Quarter at this time:

- a. The current daily schedule (used for 2nd Quarter) will be used for all of 3rd Quarter (with a high likelihood of 4th Quarter as well). This maintains the two RTI sessions (11:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.).
- b. Campus Release (with parent approval) will continue during 3rd Quarter (with a high likelihood of 4th Quarter as well) so that students only have to be on campus during class time. We anticipate this also helping minimize the number of students during lunch hour which makes social distancing easier to maintain.
- c. Current Parking will remain the same at this time. While students may have to walk from further distances within the lot, maintaining campus release is expected to help allow campus parking for all students at this time. We will make changes to this if we find we have more vehicles to park than actual parking spaces.
- d. We will NOT distinguish if a student is in class in-person or in class and fully participating online the remainder of 3rd Quarter. A student in person or online and fully participating will be counted as attending. Please note this and discuss with your student as we have been working to this point to notify parents if your student was participating online when we expected the student to be in person.

A reminder to students that RTI2 and RTI3 can be mandated by teacher request. If you are requested to RTI2 or RTI3 you are expected to attend the session for that given day. Students may also choose to attend any RTI session on any day.

Campus Release Reminders for 2nd Semester/3rd Quarter:

- 9th-10th Grade students with campus release may leave the building during periods/blocks with no scheduled class (schedule says "Campus Release"), RTI (if not requested), and during lunch.
- 9th-10th Grade students who choose to stay during your Campus Release period must report to the Learning Center (cannot be in the commons areas). 9th-10th Grade students who are not requested by a teacher yet choose to stay for RTI (always encouraged) must report to your 2nd block/4th period class for the morning RTI session and to your 4th block/8th period class for the afternoon RTI session.
- 9th-10th Grade students choose to stay for lunch may only go to assigned lunch period. Students must then report to the 2nd block/4th period classroom or to the Learning Center opposite their lunch period.

Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Sign-Up:

Updated information has now been posted regarding the second AP Exam sign-up window. Information will be posted in each AP class Schoology site. Students can also use this Link to access information on how to sign up for the AP Exam.

When you login to the payment portal you will now have 3 choices for payment instead of 2:

For any classes that started 1st quarter there is now a late fee of \$40 to take the test. (for a total of \$80) Those are the tests listed **AP Test Late Signup**. Those tests are: Biology, Calc AB, Calc BC, Computer Science Principles, Computer Science A, English Language and Composition, Language: French, Macroeconomics, Music Theory, Physics 1, Physics C Electricity and Mag., Physics C Mechanics, Statistics.

The classes that started 2nd quarter and after have no late fee and are under **AP Exam2**. The cost is \$40. Those are: US Government and Politics, Chemistry, Comparative Government, Environmental Science, World History Modern, Physics 2, Psychology.

The **AP Final Payment** is \$46. If you choose one of the other two options and make the final payment, your payment will be complete. If you only choose **AP Exam2** or **AP Test Late Signup** you will have to pay the \$46 later online or on the test day in order to take the test.
