Online-Only Student Course Material Dropoff:

Online-only students for 2nd Quarter should return course materials to the 11th-12th Grades Office. We do need to quarantine all materials for four days prior to redistribution.

3rd Quarter

The LMHS Parent Survey emailed last week is still open through today (February 2). As of this afternoon, we have had 947 responses to the survey. Thank you to everyone for completing the survey.

Planning Regarding Legislative Action for Onsite School Attendance:

The Governor has signed the bill requiring schools offer the option of on-site everyday for students. A **short survey was sent to all LMHS parents** to determine current preferences specifically related to the Hybrid model. This two-question survey is active through Tuesday, February 2. A determination will then be made whether to offer Online-Only, Hybrid, and On-Site Everyday or Online-Only and On-Site Everyday. Later this week, parents will be asked to choose which of the determined options they will select for their student(s). Starting on Monday, February 15, the new law requires all schools to allow students to choose on-site attendance every day for classes. From February 2 – February 12, LMHS will be using the current Hybrid Schedule (with Online-Only) with Group 'B' students reporting on Tuesday, February 2.

Planning is underway for how to maintain social distancing within the building given a higher number of students. Once these plans are final we will let everyone know. A few determinations have been made for all of 3rd Quarter at this time:

- a. The current daily schedule (used for 2nd Quarter) will be used for all of 3rd Quarter (with a high likelihood of 4th Quarter as well). This maintains the two RTI sessions (11:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.).
- b. Campus Release (with parent approval) will continue during 3rd Quarter (with a high likelihood of 4th Quarter as well) so that students only have to be on campus during class time. We anticipate this also helping minimize the number of students during lunch hour which makes social distancing easier to maintain.
- c. Current Parking will remain the same at this time. While students may have to walk from further distances within the lot, maintaining campus release is expected to help allow campus parking for all students at this time. We will make changes to this if we find we have more vehicles to park than actual parking spaces.

A reminder to students that RTI2 and RTI3 can be mandated by teacher request. If you are requested to RTI2 or RTI3 you are expected to attend the session for that given day. Students may also choose to attend any RTI session on any day.

Campus Release Reminders for 2nd Semester/3rd Quarter:

- 9th-10th Grade students with campus release may leave the building during periods/blocks with no scheduled class (schedule says "Campus Release"), RTI (if not requested), and during lunch.
- 9th-10th Grade students who choose to stay during your Campus Release period must report to the Learning Center (cannot be in the commons areas). 9th-10th Grade students who are not requested by a teacher yet choose to stay for RTI (always encouraged) must report to your 2nd block/4th period class for the morning RTI session and to your 4th block/8th period class for the afternoon RTI session.
- 9th-10th Grade students choose to stay for lunch may only go to assigned lunch period. Students must then report to the 2nd block/4th period classroom or to the Learning Center opposite their lunch period.

Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Sign-Up:

Updated information has now been posted regarding the second AP Exam sign-up window. Information will be posted in each AP class Schoology site. Students can also use this Link to access information on how to sign up for the AP Exam.

When you login to the payment portal you will now have 3 choices for payment instead of 2:

For any classes that started 1st quarter there is now a late fee of \$40 to take the test. (for a total of \$80) Those are the tests listed **AP Test Late Signup**. Those tests are: Biology, Calc AB, Calc BC, Computer Science Principles, Computer Science A, English Language and Composition, Language: French, Macroeconomics, Music Theory, Physics 1, Physics C Electricity and Mag., Physics C Mechanics, Statistics.

The classes that started 2nd quarter and after have no late fee and are under **AP Exam2**. The cost is \$40. Those are: US Government and Politics, Chemistry, Comparative Government, Environmental Science, World History Modern, Physics 2, Psychology.

The **AP Final Payment** is \$46. If you choose one of the other two options and make the final payment, your payment will be complete. If you only choose **AP Exam2** or **AP Test Late Signup** you will have to pay the \$46 later online or on the test day in order to take the test.

Course Registration Process for 2021-22 will take place February 8 - 12:

The online course registration process for the 2021-22 school year will take place in 3rd Quarter from **February 8 -12**. The 2021-22 LMHS Program of Studies will be available on the school website in mid-January. **Information for 2021-22 course registration** will be **discussed** during the **specific grade-level meetings in January** and also **sent** to **student email accounts** for all 9th, 10th and 11th grades.

^{2nd} Block/4th Period will be extended until 11:45 a.m. for 9th, 10th and 11th Grades on Monday, February 8:

On the first day of Course Registration, all classes will be extended until 11:45 a.m. for 9th, 10th, and 11th Grades (12th Grade students will be dismissed at 11:27 a.m. – regular dismissal time) so that students begin the online course registration process. 9th, 10th, and 11th Grades students will be dismissed at 11:45 for RTI or Campus Release. Students without Campus Release will remain in 2nd Block/4th Period.

National Merit Scholarship Opportunity via Alternative:

With the cancellation of the PSAT due to weather on January 26, **LMHS Juniors who still wish to try for National Merit Scholarships** may do so following the following three steps:

- 1) Visit https://forms.nationalmerit.org/alternateentry immediately to complete the Alternate Entry Form. You cannot be considered in the 2022 National Merit Scholarship Program unless you complete this online form no later than Thursday, April 1, 2021.
- 2) Register for and take an official administration of the SAT given by June 2021.
- 3) Request the College Board SAT Program send an official report of your SAT scores to NMSC (code 0085). *The SAT Program will not report your scores to NMSC unless you request it.* You cannot use a photocopy of the score report sent to you or to your high school as a substitute for the official report.
