## 3rd Quarter

## Iowa State-wide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP):

On Monday, April 5 and Tuesday, April 6, LMHS Grades 9, 10, and 11, will be taking the Iowa State-wide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP). The exams will be taken in the afternoon of April 5 and the morning of April 6. Grades 9, 10, and 11, will each take the Math, Reading and Literacy-Writing Exams. Grade 10 will also take the Science Exam. These exams are required by the State of Iowa. Students will need their school-issued computers for all exams. PLEASE MAKE YOU'RE YOUR COMPUTER IS FULLY CHARGED PRIOR TO TAKING THE ISASP EACH DAY. Students with accommodations for the exams will have a separate schedule that will be sent separately to each student taking exams with accommodations. Please note that when exam times have ended on April 5, students are done for the day. Grade 12 will be dismissed at 12:00 p.m. on April 5 until 1:00 p.m. on April 6.

More Specific Information will be sent to Students and Parents in the weeks prior to the exams on April 5 and April 6. Both April 5 and April 6 will be Group 'A' days. **Group 'B' students will also be onsite for ISASP exams.** Parents of Online-Only students have been sent a questionnaire regarding whether their students will take the exams on campus as scheduled on April 5-6 or on campus on April 9 (teacher workday-no classes). We will provide information regarding any potential bussing changes for these days as well.

## Online-Only Student Computer Updates Required Prior to ISASP:

Online-Only Students will need to do updates on your school-issued computer prior to taking the ISASP. You can either come to exams at least 45 minutes early to ensure updates are completed before the exam before your exams OR stop on campus to log on before April 5 or April 9, whichever date you will begin the ISASP, to have the updates completed.

## Information Regarding 3rd Quarter:

A few determinations have been made for all of 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter at this time:

- a. The current daily schedule (used for 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter) will be used for all of 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter (with a high likelihood of 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter as well). This maintains the two RTI sessions (11:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.).
- b. Campus Release (with parent approval) will continue during 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter (with a high likelihood of 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter as well) so that students only have to be on campus during class time. We anticipate this also helping minimize the number of students during lunch hour which makes social distancing easier to maintain.
- c. Current Parking will remain the same at this time. While students may have to walk from further distances within the lot, maintaining campus release is expected to help allow campus parking for all students at this time. While we have more vehicles parking in the campus lots at this time, plenty of spaces remain available in our lots during the day.
- d. We will NOT distinguish if a student is in class in-person or in class and fully participating online the remainder of 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter. A student in person or online and fully participating will be counted as attending. Please note this and discuss with your student as we have been working to this point to notify parents if your student was participating online when we expected the student to be in person.

A reminder to students that RTI2 and RTI3 can be mandated by teacher request. If you are requested to RTI2 or RTI3 you are expected to attend the session for that given day. Students may also choose to attend any RTI session on any day.

## Campus Release Reminders for 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester/3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter:

- 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> Grade students with campus release may leave the building during periods/blocks with no scheduled class (schedule says "Campus Release"), RTI (if not requested), and during lunch.
- 9th-10th Grade students who choose to stay during your Campus Release period must report to the Learning Center (cannot be in the commons areas). 9th-10th Grade students who are not requested by a teacher yet choose to stay for RTI (always encouraged) must report to your 2nd block/4th period class for the morning RTI session and to your 4th block/8th period class for the afternoon RTI session.

• 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> Grade students choose to stay for lunch may only go to assigned lunch period. Students must then report to the 2<sup>nd</sup> block/4<sup>th</sup> period classroom or to the Learning Center opposite their lunch period.

## LMHS 4th Quarter Hybrid Schedule:

The current LMHS 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter Hybrid Schedule will be maintained during 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter. Starting April 12, we will simply refer to this as the LMHS 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Hybrid Schedule.

## Changes in CDC Guidance in Classroom Settings:

Many of you are aware that the CDC has adjusted guidance for schools concerning distancing within the classroom setting. The new guidance **allows for 3' between student seating in a classroom** (this has been 6'). At this time, our intention will be to make adjustments within classrooms as needed, from 6' to 3', starting in 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter (April 12). (We will maintain the maximum distance within the classroom unless student numbers dictate a need to lower the distance to no less than 3'). This is *only in the classroom setting* and all other precautions will remain in place, including mask wearing at all times and social distancing in all other areas of the school building (e.g. commons areas, cafeteria).

We will provide more information in the next week regarding the process for those planning to return to in-person school in either the Hybrid or Everyday format for 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter.
