Hybrid Schedule for 2nd Quarter

The School Board determined on Monday night that LMHS will continue with the Hybrid model through 2nd Quarter. You can use this link to the draft of the LMHS 2nd Quarter Hybrid Schedule:

Linn-Mar High School Hybrid Daily Schedule for 2nd Quarter 2020-21

A few adjustments have been made to the 2nd Quarter Hybrid Schedule. First, each period has been increased to 33 minutes, with blocks becoming 71 minutes. Second, the school day has been split into two sessions each followed by an RTI session. The morning session includes the first four periods/two blocks followed by a 30 minute RTI session. The afternoon session includes the last four periods/two blocks also followed by a 30 minute RTI session. The individual time provided by the RTI time has been lessoned by one hour with the half hour after morning classes and again after the afternoon classes. Third, 'priority' designation has been made for Monday-Thursday RTI sessions, however, RTI is can be used for any class each day. If a teacher makes an RTI request on a day that class has 'priority' a student will report to that class for RTI. Also, if a teacher makes an RTI request on a non-'priority' day and the 'priority' class does not request a student, then the student will report to the requesting teacher. Fourth, we will open the building from 8:05-8:15 a.m. for a before school RTI and Quiet Study session each day. Students wanting to study individually in the commons areas may do so during this time. RTI is also available with all teachers in classrooms during this time. The building will then open for all classes at 8:35 a.m.

Study Table/Quiet Study will continue during the Lunch Hour for students who choose not or are not able to leave the building.

For most students during online class days, the amount of max. screen time during 2nd Quarter classes (minus RTI) will be between 4-4.5 hours. Currently, for 1st Quarter, most students have a max. screen time during classes (minus RTI) of 3.5-4 hours depending upon their class schedule. We do understand that students are doing a lot of

Advanced Placement (AP) Exams (Signup and Payment):

Registration Window #1 is now open for Advance Placement Exam Registration. Students taking AP classes that began at the start of the school year and "Exam Only" students need to order their exams by Friday, November 6th. Examples of Exam Only students are Online APEX AP classes (1st and 2nd semester), Physics C and self-study (including students retaking exams for a better score).

The total cost of an AP exam is \$86 this year. \$40 is due now to order your exam. The remaining \$46 will be due on exam day. Payments can be made online at the Linn-Mar Online Payment Portal or in person to Mrs. Dayton in the Linn-Mar High School Cashier's Office.

The ordering process has changed from previous years. Paper order forms <u>will not</u> be utilized. To complete your AP exam order, login to your class section on the myap.collegeboard.org site, using the section code provided by your teacher, and change your Exam Registration choice from "Undecided" to "Yes".

The AP Exam Registration Window #1 closes on Friday, November 6th. All payments must be turned in by the deadline to have an exam ordered for you.

PSAT Date for LMHS:

The date of the PSAT administered for Linn-Mar High School students on **Tuesday, January 26, 2021**. It is possible this exam will be taken at the Doubletree Conference Center in downtown Cedar Rapids. Once transportation is arranged and details are finalized we will let everyone know. The exam will begin at 9:30 a.m. if held at the Doubletree Conference Center. This location can hold a large number of our students while also maintaining social distancing. Sign-up for 11th and interested 10th and 9th Grade students will start on November 2 and continue through December 4. Sign-up is in the Cashier's Office and cost to the student, payable at sign-up, to take the exam is \$17. Only 11th Grade students are eligible for National Merit Scholarships and Recognition.
