-Journeys Daily Sentence and Morning Work

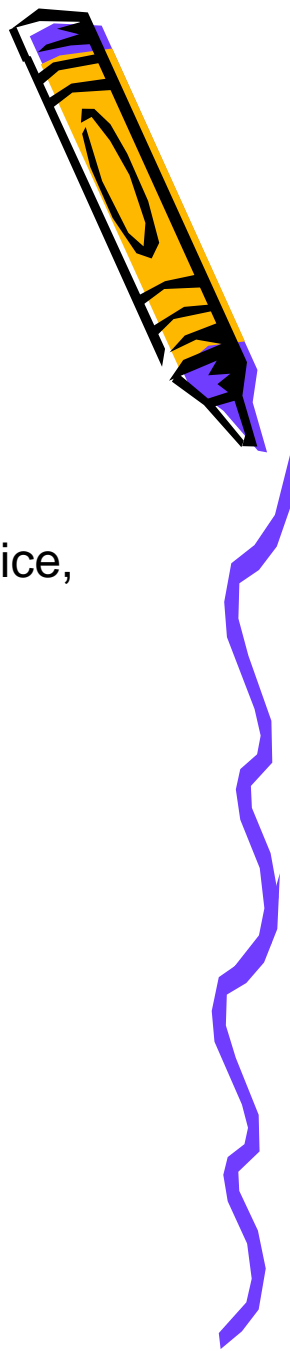
Writing

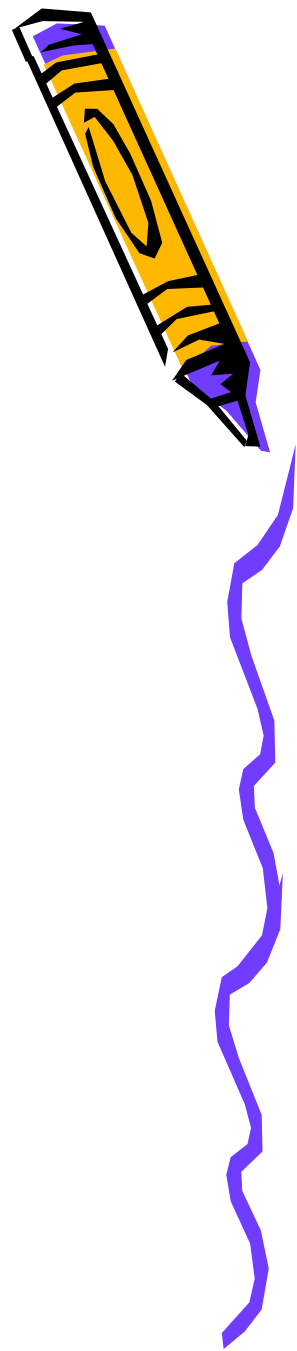

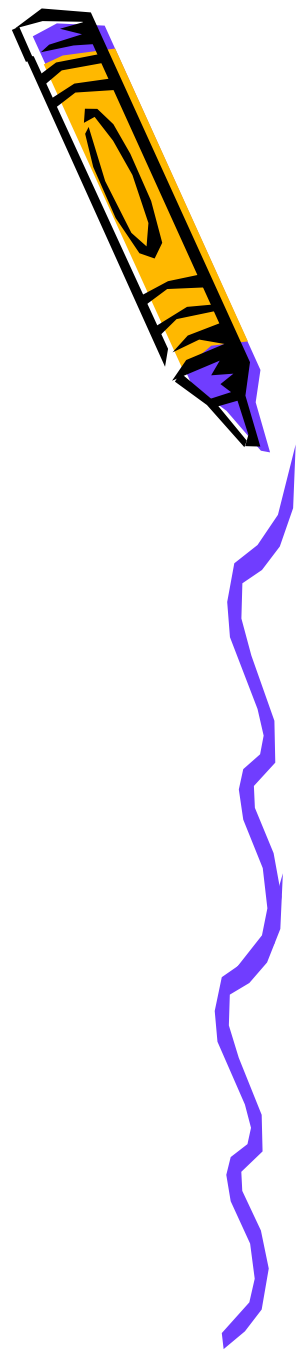
Homework

Grading and Assessment

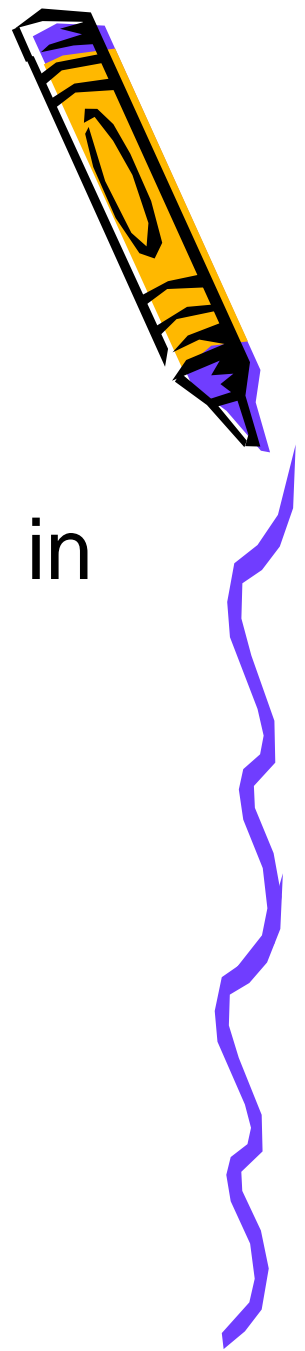
- Focus on modeling and guided practice

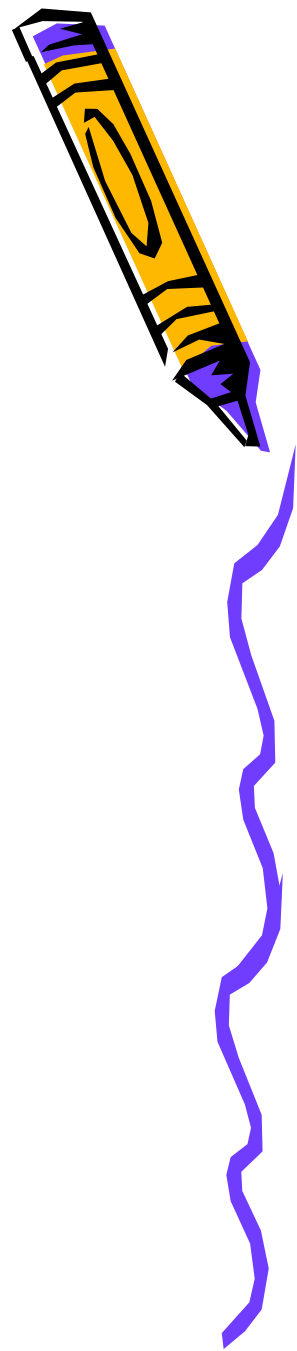
