- Building Opens for Students at 8:25 a.m. Doors #3 and #13 will open at 8:25 a.m. Students will not be allowed to enter the building prior to 8:25 a.m. unless in Zero Period Marching Band, verified for an organizational or other meeting, practice, workout, or study session with a teacher. Face masks must be worn upon entry and during time within the building.
- ** Lunches and Study Table A one-hour lunch and study table will be held. Students with signed parent permission forms in respective grade level offices will be allowed to leave campus during lunch. Lunch I and II will be determined by a student's 6th period/3rd block class. Students will remain in 6th period or 3rd block classes for a learning center opposite of their lunch session.
- *** RTI/Review/Homework/Enrichment/Extension Sessions These scheduled times will be designated as either required or requested assistance/work study in each class. Students will be required to attend the session for any class if receiving a 'D' level, 'not passing', or incomplete grade, or any priority standard score of '2' or below in a class. Students wanting extra review/support/enrichment may request and attend the RTI Sessions. Teachers may also choose to use this time for assessment/lab extension/lesson extension or other reasons as needed for the class.
