FROM THE PRINCIPAL

PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCES

October 11th and 13th are Westfield's first common night Parent/Teacher Conferences of this new school year. If you were not able to complete your online conference schedule, please contact your child's teacher immediately.

Studies have shown that children whose parents are involved in their education do better in school. Parent-teacher conferences are one way to get involved. Every time you attend a parent-teacher conference, you learn more about your child and strengthen the bond with your child's school. Getting to know the teacher and hearing his or her views of your child's progress actually helps your child succeed. So, make parent-teacher conferences a priority and take the following steps to ensure you and your child get the most out of them.

Before the conference:

- *Talk with your child*: Find out his or her favorite subjects and activities, and ask if there are any concerns he or she would like you to discuss with the teacher.
- Review assignments: Are there some areas where your child really shines and others that might need a little extra work? Discuss both strengths and weaknesses with the teacher.
- Check whether your child should attend: In most cases, the conferences are strictly between the parents and the teachers, so you'll probably need to make child-care arrangements.

The day of the conference:

- Be on time: The conference schedule is tight and teachers need all parents to be on time. If something comes up, notify the teacher as soon as possible. Try to reschedule, even if it has to be a telephone conference.
- Remember that conferences are brief: A typical parent-teacher conference lasts 20 minutes. If you need additional time, ask for a follow-up session.
- *Keep an open mind*: Some parents get angry when teachers discuss trouble spots. Remember that these conferences are meant to help you understand your child's school performance. Working together with the teacher will help your child succeed.
- *Make plans*: Find out what you can do to follow through at home. Decide together what you, your child, and the teacher need to do to help your child succeed.

Afterward:

- Tell your child: After the conference, meet with your child and discuss the teacher's comments.
 Remember to praise all the things your child is doing well and pass along the teacher's compliments. If you need to, talk about areas that you and the teacher will be working on to help your child improve.
- Follow up: In the days and weeks that follow, let your child's teacher know that you are following through on what was discussed, and that you'd like to hear how things are progressing in the classroom.

Remember that schools and teachers welcome parent involvement year-round. Feel free to call and schedule a phone or in-person conference any time you think there's a need. Westfield's Parent-Teacher conference nights are Tuesday, October 11, and Thursday, October 13. Please check with your child's teacher if you have not been notified.


Communication notifications for the District can be signed up for in the following ways:

If you would like your child/children to participate in a group at Westfield that deals with living in a divorced/separated family situation, please continue to read and complete the permission slip below.

The group will meet 1/week for approximately 6 weeks. This meeting time will take place during the school day. The facilitator of the group will be Kasi Shanahan, Westfield School Counselor. The group members are asked to keep what is said in the group confidential in regards to the names of other students. They are, however, encouraged to talk to both of their parents regarding the content of the group and their own thoughts and feelings. The students will be bringing home a paper each session (one copy for mom and one for dad) to facilitate discussion with you as parents.

The goals of the group are:

- Children will understand factual information about divorce.
- Children will understand that divorce is not a result of their actions.
- Children will recognize and understand how divorce is common among families.
- Children will understand and accept their parents love for them as permanent.
- Children will learn to identify, understand and express their feeling.
- Children will learn to trust a support person with their feelings.
- Children will learn appropriate coping skills.

If both parents are involved in the child/children's life, I like both parents to give permission for this group. If you have more than one child attending Westfield, you may put them all on the same permission slip.
