Each includes 2 anchor texts.
Focus Walls give overviews of skills and books for the week.
Introduces students to poetry, informational text, fiction, and non-fiction.
Introduces nouns, pronouns, verbs, adverbs, and adjectives.

Jolly Phonics

43 letter sounds
First set is S, A, T, I, P
Students can start reading and writing after the first set.
Each sounds has a story, song, action, handwriting sheet, and poster.
Works on consonants, vowels, and diagraphs.
Works on letter sounds, formations, blending, and segmenting.

Writing

We use the Zaner-Bloser curriculum to teach letter formations.

- O Pre-writing strokes
- O Letter Formations

O Work on sentence formation.

- O Capital letters
- O Lower case letters

O Students will be expected to write a 3 sentence narrative piece by the end of the year.
