On behalf of the faculty and staff of Linn-Mar High School, let me congratulate upcoming graduates of the Linn-Mar Class of 2018. The purpose of this letter is to provide graduation information to parents/guardians and to communicate the school's expectations during the remaining days of high school for seniors. We hope that you will find this information helpful with your graduation planning.

COMMENCEMENT: Sunday, May 27, 2018 at 1:00 p.m., U.S. Cellular Center

PARKING: Ramps, lots under I-380, and on-street parking. SEATING: All public seating is free. No tickets are required.

BROADCAST: Commencement will be broadcast on KCRG 9.2 for those unable to attend. PHOTOGRAPHER: A professional photographer will take a picture of each graduate as s/he receives a diploma. The photographer will contact you directly regarding picture purchases. Any purchase of pictures is optional.

REHEARSAL: <u>Graduation rehearsal is mandatory and scheduled for Wednesday, May 23, at 1:00 p.m.</u> All Seniors are to report to the Main Gym before 1:00 p.m.

SENIOR RECOGNITION NIGHT: We welcome parents and community members as guests at 7:00 p.m., Monday, May 7, in the high school auditorium as we honor the individual achievements by the members of the Class of 2018. All Scholarships and awards must be confirmed by bringing an award letter or certificate to the Counseling Office no later than April 20th. All individual achievements that are recognized on the evening of May 7th will also be recognized in the graduation program.

END OF THE YEAR EXPECTATIONS:

- 1. <u>Attendance</u>: Senior attendance should remain a top priority as additional unexcused absences and truancies may have a negative effect on grades, credits toward graduation, and affect a student's "good standing."
- 2. "Good Standing": Only those students who have met all graduation requirements (seniors in "good standing") will participate in Commencement.
- 3. Obligations: All graduates are to have their book/library fines and other obligations taken care of by Friday, May 18, 2018.
- 4. <u>Transfer Credit:</u> Courses taken for credit toward graduation from institutions other than Linn-Mar must be completed by Friday, May 18, 2018.
- 5. <u>School Rules:</u> All graduates must abide by school rules through Commencement. Misbehavior on graduation day may jeopardize the student's participation in the ceremony.
- 6. <u>Seniors' Last Day</u>: The last day of school for seniors in good standing is scheduled for Wednesday, May 23, 2018, with dismissal at the <u>conclusion</u> of rehearsal. Many seniors will volunteer to participate in organized community service the morning of the 23rd. All seniors are expected to be on-time and in attendance at school or their assigned service site.
