

# **A-L-I-C-E training**

We will have our controlled evacuation drills the first week of May.

We will be walking to Lowe Park, which is our initial evacuation site. This drill is intended to teach students the route, as well as where to go once they arrive at Lowe Park. This evacuation will be used in the event of an emergency situation in which we would need to vacate the building or premises. We will reschedule the drill if it is raining. # BREAKING NEWS FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE FOR 6<sup>TH</sup> GRADE PARENTS

Attention Parents of Sixth Grade Students:

The Iowa Department of Public Health has released new immunization requirements for the 2017-18 school year.

# All students enrolling in 7th grade must meet the following guideline *PRIOR* TO THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL:

- 1 dose of meningococcal vaccine administered after the age of 10
- 1 dose of Tdap vaccine (Tetanus, Diptheria, and Pertussis) administered after the age of 7

# PER IOWA IMMUNIZAION LAW - YOUR STUDENT WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND SCHOOL UNTIL PROOF OF THIS VACCINATION IS PROVIDED TO THE LM HEALTH OFFICE.

There will be NO grace/extension period for the implementation of this requirement.


# <u>Your student will not be able to attend classes August 23<sup>rd</sup> and will be sent home</u> until the vaccination is received.

This immunization can be received at your physician office or Linn-County public health department (319-892-6000). Walk-in clinics do not provide this vaccination.

Parents can provide proof of immunization to the LM Health Office by sending proof of immunization via mail, fax, email or drop off record to health office.

# **NEWS FROM THE HEALH OFFICE**

### **END OF THE YEAR MEDICATION PICK UP**

If you child takes a medication at school, please plan accordingly when replenishing your child's supply this month. Any medication that is left over on the last day needs to be picked up from school by 3 p.m. on May 31st. If it is not picked up it will be destroyed. It is Linn-Mar district policy that we are not allowed to send any medications home with your student. This includes daily prescribed medications and any "as needed" medications such as Tylenol or Ibuprofen. Please contact the Health Office at 447-3415 with any questions you may have.

### **6<sup>TH</sup> GRADERS REQUIRED IMMUNIZATION PRIOR TO 7<sup>TH</sup> GRADE:**

Incoming 7th graders for fall 2017-18 are required to have a Tdap and Meningitis immunization. Tdap is a tetanus and pertussis containing vaccine. It became a required immunization prior to 7th grade due to the increase of whooping cough in recent years. The Meningitis immunization is a new requirement for entry into 7th grade as of January 2017. If your student has not had these immunizations yet, please make plans to have it completed over the summer. You will need to supply a copy of your students updated immunization record to the Health Office at the time of fall registration as proof of vaccination. If your student has not received the vaccine or has a medical/religious waiver on file prior to the first day of school (August 23, 2017) they will not be allowed to attend school. At conference time, you received a letter indicating whether we have record of these immunizations on your child. If you think your student may have already had this shot, please contact your doctors office and have them fax us a copy of their immunization record to 373-3222. If you have any questions, please contact the Health Office at 447-3415.

### LOOKING AHEAD TO FALL:

Health office staff will be in the office again full time starting on August 21<sup>ST</sup>. If your student will need to take prescription medication at school, please utilize these few days before school begins to drop off your students medications and to get the proper paperwork completed. Prescription oral medication only requires a parent signature and prescription bottle. Inhalers, even though they are prescribed require both a parent signature and a physician signature to give permission for the student to self-administer the inhaler. Any over the counter medications such as Tylenol, Advil, cold medicines, and Benadryl require a parent signature and physician signature. By dropping needed medications off prior to the first day of school, it will make sure we have everything available when your student needs it.




# **BOX TOPS**

# **NOTES FROM OFFICE**

#### ABSENCES:

Parents must call the school by 9:00 A.M. when a child will not be in school or will be late for any reason. You may leave a voice mail on the attendance line, 447-3413, 24 hours a day. Please leave your student's first and last name, reason for absence, and a phone number where you can be reached. If we have not received a call by 9:00 A.M, we will attempt to contact you at all phone numbers available to us. If we are unable to verify your child's absence, a visit to the home may be necessary. The absence will remain as unexcused until we hear from you.

### HOMEWORK:

If a student has been absent for two or more days, you may call the attendance line and request homework. Requests must be received by 9:00 A.M. and homework will be ready to pick up after 2:00 P.M.

### LEAVING DURING THE DAY:

Please send a note with your child to bring to the office before school. They will be issued an early dismissal pass, which allows the student to leave class early and wait for you in the main office. This eliminates classroom interruptions. You must come in to sign them out.

If your child needs to leave school unexpectedly, you may call the attendance number and a pass will be delivered to the student at the next WOW time. If a student needs to leave before passes are delivered, we will call your child down when you come in to sign them out. Please allow as much notice as possible to avoid classroom interruptions.

#### ARRIVING LATE TO SCHOOL:

Class begins promptly at 8:00 A.M. Students who arrive after 8:00 A.M must sign in at the office. This is considered a late entry. Students in the building but not in class at 8:00 A.M. are considered tardy.
