It is necessary to have the "official" cap (w/tassel) and gown to participate in the graduation ceremony and Herff Jones is the official Linn-Mar cap and gown provider. In previous years, graduates purchased caps and tassels, but rented and returned Commencement gowns. As chosen by Class of 2018 student leadership, each 2018 graduate will purchase his or her cap, tassel, and "keeper" gown for this year's Commencement. Information regarding the ordering of a cap and gown will be provided to potential 2018 graduates in October. Members of the Class of 2018 may submit an order for purchase at any time from October through the end of December.
