Order forms will be sent home with students that day, and available at the concert.

In preparation for the concert we will be practicing together THAT morning BEFORE school (7:30 am – 8:30 am) in the HS Auditorium. STEAM stands for science, technology, engineering, art and math. Last year, it was all about the organization and experiencing the activities, but this year students are being taught about the 4C's and how they play a part in each activity.

#### FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE

As cold weather keeps us indoors, unfortunately germs can be easily spread. Please remind your children to practice basic hygiene skills...especially keeping hands clean and coughing into elbows instead of hands!

Please continue to use the guidelines below for illness. It is helpful to the Health Office if you are specific in reporting illness symptoms. For example, let us know if "flu" means vomiting/diarrhea versus the cough/cold symptoms seen with Influenza A, B, or H1N1. Thanks for your help!

#### **ILLNESS:**

- Please notify the main or health offices if your child is diagnosed with a\_communicable disease. (e.g. strep throat, influenza, whooping cough, mono, pink eye, etc.).
- Please do not send your child to school until fever free (<100 degrees) for 24 hours.</li>
- Please do not send your child to school until free of vomiting and/or diarrhea for 24 hours.

COUGH DROPS/THROAT LOZENGES only require a written permission note from the parent/guardian. They MUST be kept in the health office, where the student will remain until the entire lozenge is dissolved.

ALL OTHER MEDS require that parents fill out a Linn-Mar Medication Permission Form. Over-the counter medications will need a physician signature.

#### **HEAD LICE:**

Parents/Guardians-please remind your children to avoid sharing hats, scarves, combs, brushes, and clothing to help prevent the spread of lice. Thank you!

#### **CLOTHING DONATIONS:**

Thank you for all the generous donations of clothing this year to the Health Office!!! If you are cleaning closets, extra elastic/drawstring-waisted pants sizes 6-10 are always in short supply here. If your child comes home in Health Office clothing, please remember to wash and return the clothing as soon as possible. If your child needs frequent clothing changes at school, please consider keeping an extra change of clothing in his/her backpack.

#### **GRANT WOOD HEARING SCREENING:**

Grant Wood will provide hearing testing at Bowman Woods on March 23, 2018, for grades 2 and 5, for students in other grades with known hearing loss, for students new to Bowman Woods, and for absences/rechecks. If you do NOT want your child's hearing screened, please contact the main or health offices and/or consult the Bowman Woods Family Handbook online.


