Linn-Mar Community School District Bond Vote 2018

Bond Vote Set For September 11

On September 11th, voters in the Linn-Mar district will be asked to consider a plan that calls for the construction of two 5th-6th grade intermediate buildings. The intermediate schools will provide desperately needed space for nine of the district's schools.

The bond is part of the district's 10-year facilities master plan to strategically address existing and long-term capacity issues in the rapidly-growing district. Enrollment at the school district has increased from 5,267 to nearly 7,800 students since 2005. Several of the district's elementary and middle schools are near or over capacity as a result of the sustained growth.

If the \$55 million general obligation bond is approved by a 60 percent majority of voters, the property tax rate would increase \$0.65 on every \$1,000 of taxable value. The increase equates to approximately \$5.91 a month in additional property taxes for the owner of a \$200,000 home.

In addition to constructing two intermediate schools, the district will restructure to a new grade format — PK/K-4; 5-6; 7-8; and 9-12 — for the 2020-21 school year.

The district's long-term plans are dependent upon continued growth in the district, economic conditions in the community, and additional variables — such as the extension of the SAVE fund — that dictate the district's timeline.

The community is invited to attend one of two open houses in August to learn about the bond and long-term plans. The first open house will be held at Indian Creek Elementary on Wednesday, August 15th from 5:00 – 6:30 pm. The second open house will be held at Bowman Woods Elementary on Tuesday, August 28th from 6:30 – 8:00 pm. Members of the Linn-Mar Board of Education and Superintendent Shannon Bisgard will be there to explain the facilities plan and Sept. 11 referendum.

Registration for 2018-2019

eRegistration on PowerSchool will open August 6.

Please complete your eRegistration by August 20.

All families will need to log on to PowerSchool and complete an eRegistration for each student at Indian Creek. You will need your PowerSchool username and password to log on (just a reminder the username and password were created by you when you set up your PowerSchool account.) Be sure to go through each screen, making any changes that need to be made and click submit at the bottom of the page (this will save all changes). If you do not need to make changes you will still need to click through the screens on PowerSchool and click submit at the bottom of each screen. Be sure to complete the permissions at the end of the eRegistration as these need to be updated every year. Also, just a reminder, the "Use of Student Photographs, Videos, and Likenesses", "Student Internet Access", and "Student Online Accounts" have changed as of July 1, 2015 and now require a letter to be written to their building principal no later than September 15th (or within two weeks of student enrollment if enrollment occurs after this date) if parents/guardians have objections to these three permissions.

You may also pay school fees and deposit money into your family lunch account at this time ~ all online. We encourage you to complete all of your 2018-19 registration online.

For those who are not able to complete their eRegistration online, a walk in registration will be held on August 14th during regular office hours (7:30-3:30). The walk in registration will simply consist of completing your eRegistration on a school computer, if needed, and paying your fees in person. If you have completed your eRegistration and have paid your fees online you do **not** need to come to the walk in registration.

Indian Creek Newsletters

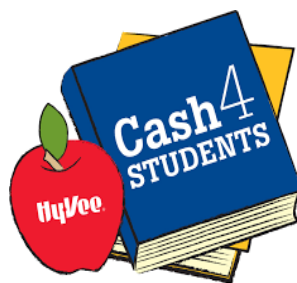

Hy-VEE Cash 4 Students

A Few Reminders For Our Visitors

We require that **ALL** of our Indian Creek visitors sign in at the office and obtain a visitors badge which needs be worn the entire time you are visiting Indian Creek. When leaving the building, make sure to stop in the office to sign out. Please note that this is a safety policy of the Linn-Mar District and is meant for everyone visiting Indian Creek during the school day whether or not you are staying just a few minutes, staying a long time, or you are a frequent visitor/volunteer.

Volunteering:

We ask when you are volunteering at Indian Creek to please check in at the office, obtain a visitors badge, and record your volunteer hours on the volunteer computer. The district does host a 100-Hour Volunteer Recognition each year for those volunteers who reach 100 or more hours during the school year.

Visiting For Lunch:

If you will be joining your child for lunch, please be sure to phone Mrs. Strauser (447-3272) by 9:00 AM to order your lunch the day you plan on coming. We do ask that you check in at the office when you arrive to sign in, obtain a visitors badge, pay for your meal, if needed, or you may have the amount deducted directly from your child's lunch account, then you may either wait in the office or on the bench located directly outside of the office for your child to come from their classroom to the cafeteria. Please note that the office does **NOT** keep cash on hand so if you plan to pay in cash please have exact change.

Miscellaneous Reminders:

- If your child has forgotten something from home, you may leave it in the office and we will make sure your child receives the item. We do ask, to not add distractions to learning, that you do not go to the classroom yourself to deliver the item.
- All visitors should have made arrangements with the teacher prior to arriving at school for a visit.
- When visiting please be respectful and remember that school is in session from 8:00 AM to 2:45 PM.
- Younger siblings should not visit the classroom with you unless approved by the teacher in advance.
- Visitors should not bring gifts (balloons, flowers, etc.) to students at school.
- Animals are not allowed in the building; unless approved by the teacher in advance.

****** ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL DETAILS ******

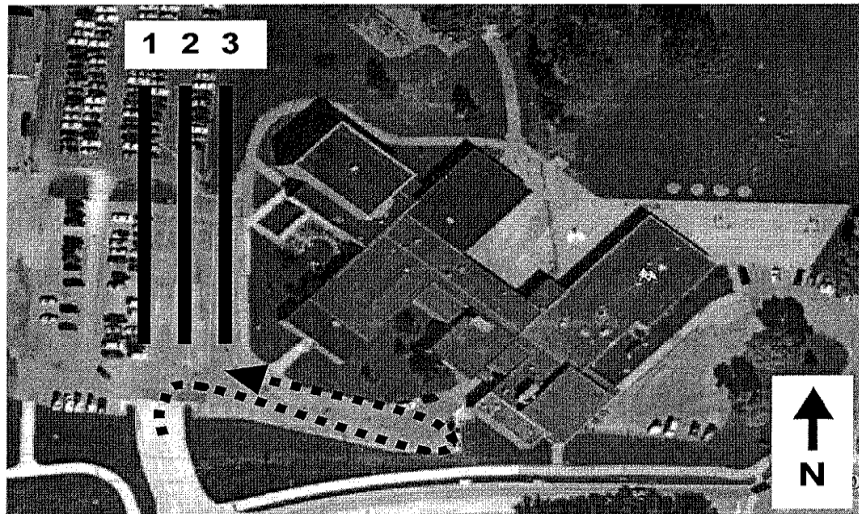
Students **traveling by car** at regular arrival and dismissal times should be dropped off or picked up at the back gym entrance at the rear of the building. The back gym entrance will be unlocked only during arrival and dismissal times (7:35-8:00 a.m. and 2:45-3:00 p.m.) Parents dropping off or picking up students at other times should park in the visitor parking at the front of the building and come to the office to sign children in or out.

Please help us by **not parking by the front entrance between 7:30 and 8:00 a.m. or between 2:30 and 3:00 p.m. as our busses need all available room to turn around.**

Crossing guards will be out at 7:35 to 7:55 to cross students in the morning.

Thank you too, for helping our students experience independence by coming into the building on their own, unless it is after 8:00 AM, which then requires a parent to sign students in.

Indian Creek Elementary Student Drop Off & Pick Up Procedures



AM Drop Off

- Enter Indian Creek's west parking lot – 29th Avenue entrance.
- Drive north, next to the sidewalk by the building into lane 3. Pull up as far north as possible. First car in line will park just beyond the corner of the gym. Student exits car on passenger side. Drivers: Please remain in your car.
- If the lane is full, pull behind the leader cars winding in a U shape (dotted line with arrow) holding pattern on the south side of the building. Lane 3 will reload as the leader cars exit.
- Wait for the cars ahead of you to exit first. Drive to the end of lane and turn left, staying on the far edge of the parking lot back to the 29th Avenue entrance.

PM Pick Off Up

- Enter Indian Creek's west parking lot – 29th Avenue entrance.
- 3 lanes are identified next to the sidewalk. Fill lane 1 first, then 2 & 3. The first car in each lane will park just beyond the north corner of the gym. If the lanes are full, additional cars will wind in a U shape (dotted line with arrow) and wait for instructions from the parking lot supervisors.
- Using a walkie-talkie, a supervisor will identify drivers and call for students. Students will walk down the passenger side of each lane to load, following the instructions given them by the supervisors. Please remain in your car.
- If still waiting for your student and the lane is ready to exit, pull forward and park on the north edge of the lot. A supervisor will escort your student to the car.



Attendance Procedures

Please be sure to call the Indian Creek office (**Mrs. Strauser at 447-3272**) by 8:30 AM when your student is going to be absent or late to school. Be sure to state your student's name, classroom teacher, reason for absence or late arrival, anticipated time your student will arrive if applicable, and lunch choice.

If we do not hear from parents, Mrs. Strauser will call home to find out why the child is not at school. All illnesses are reported to the school nurse. The nurse uses this information to help monitor current contagious diseases that may spread through the building.

If your student arrives late or leaves early, parents need to stop in the office to sign them in or out. Students are asked to check in at the office with a parent when arriving to school late.

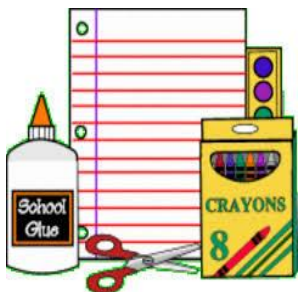
If you plan to pick up your child from school during school hours, a **written note** should be sent to your child's teacher. **Students *will not* be called to the office until a parent or guardian arrives to sign them out.** Please do not go to your child's classroom, someone from the office will either call the classroom or go down to the classroom and get your student to meet you in the office.

Our first priority is to make sure your child reaches the proper destination after school. If you need to change the way your child typically goes home in the afternoon, **please send a written note** to your child's teacher the morning stating how your child will be going home from school. ***We do not recommend e-mails simply because e-mails are not a guarantee that your message will be received in time.***



E-Mail from Indian Creek

Mrs. Harder (Pam) will send out a weekly e-mail with important information for the week, look for these e-mails on Monday afternoons. She will also send reminders and notifications throughout the school year. Please be sure your e-mail is up to date in PowerSchool, this is where the e-mail addresses are pulled from. If you have not been receiving the e-mail messages from Mrs. Harder, please email her at pharder@linnmar.k12.ia.us and she will be sure to add you to the list. Just a reminder; sometimes our e-mail messages end up in your junk folder due to the large amount of recipients we send messages to. A simple way to prevent the e-mail from going to your junk folder is to add pharder@linnmar.k12.ia.us to your address book.



Back to School Supply Kit Pick Up Days

If you ordered a back to school supply kit, last spring, online from shopkits.com, the supply kits will be available for pick up on August 13 for Kindergarteners and August 14 for students entering grades 1-5. If you do not pick up your child's kit you may pick it up on August 22 during supply drop off.



Notes From the Health Office



If your child comes down with an illness that requires taking medication at school, your pharmacy will split your prescriptions so that your child can bring only the needed amount of his/her medication to school. This will eliminate sending prescription bottles back and forth. Please let Mrs. Rosendale know if your child changes medications, so that the information can be added to their health records.

Healthy Kids Initiative

The staff at Linn-Mar Community schools has committed to promoting the health and well-being of our students. In accordance with Linn-Mar's Designation as a Blue Zone School District, new procedures have been implemented to provide students with healthier lifestyle choices in regards to birthday celebrations in the classrooms.

Student birthdays may be celebrated at school. However, students will be encouraged to no longer bring food or beverages to share with classmates. Instead, birthdays can be celebrated with non-food options including (but not limited to) name recognition on the school announcements, a special acknowledgement from the school office and classroom recognitions (i.e. birthday crowns, sit with a special friend at lunch, being designated as the line leader for the day, etc.) Students may also choose to bring in non-food items to share with classmates and school staff such as pencils, special note pads, pens, other writing tools.

What is Blue Zone?

Blue Zone began as a National Geographic expedition to find the longest living cultures and has evolved into a recipe for living longer that is now popping up as Blue Zone Projects across the country.

Blue Zone Projects are a community well-being improvement initiative designed to make healthy choices easier through permanent changes to environment, policy, and social networks.

In keeping with the Blue Zone Project here at Indian Creek we are making healthier choices too. Our lunch program has already made healthier choices for our students. We are also asking snack/birthday treats are in line with Blue Zone guidelines. Listed below are a few suggestions for snacks. Thank you for your cooperation in making Indian Creek a Blue Zone School!

Healthy Snack Options

- Fruits
- Dried Fruits

- Low and Non-fat Yogurt
- Applesauce (with no added sugar)
- Whole grain crackers
- Hummus

- Barnum Animal Crackers (due to peanut allergies Barnum is the only brand)

- Go-gurts
- Pretzels
- Jello
- Snack Pack Pudding
- Welch's fruit snacks
- Cottage Cheese (skim or 1%)
- Sun Chips-Cheddar Harvest
- Whole grain Wheat Thins
- Triscuits



Other guidelines to go by...

- All items must be trans-fat-free
- Snack items must be 200 calories or less per portion as packaged
- Calories from saturated fat must be less than 10% per serving
- Sodium must be limited to less than 230 mg per portion as packaged and less than 480 mg per entrée
- Items should contain no more than 35% of calories from total sugars per portion as packaged
- Products with cereal grains must contain at least 2 grams of fiber per package

Payment Options:

1. **Cash or checks may be sent to school daily.**
2. On-line credits may be entered at <https://intouch.linnmar.k12.ia.us/>. Follow the prompts to access your account.
3. **Credit and debit cards are acceptable.** Deposits must be completed by 8:00 a.m. in order for funds to be available for same day purchases.
4. There is **no fee** for this service.

Meal Account Balances

Meal account balances from the 2017-18 school year have automatically rolled to the building where your student will attend for the 2018-19 school year.

Free and Reduced Meal Eligibility

If your family is eligible for free school meals based on **food stamp eligibility**, you do not have to complete a new application for the 2017-18 school year. If you qualify for free or reduced meals based on your **income**, we will need a new application completed in August. Forms will be mailed to households this summer. Please return your form on registration day. Sometimes families are surprised to see the upper limits of eligibility. Please take time to read through the information you receive. Reduced price meals are \$.30 for breakfast and \$.40 for lunch. This can be a BIG savings for families. All meal choices are available to all students regardless of their status. Information regarding meal status is confidential and is not "identifiable" at the cashier station. Please contact the Nutrition Services office at 447-3302 if you have questions.

Joining us for Lunch.....

Would you like to join us for lunch? We are pleased to see so many parents of elementary students eating lunch at school. Since we do satellite food to several of our elementary buildings, we ask that you phone ahead to let the school office know if you plan to eat lunch at school. Simply call **Mrs. Strauser at 447-3272 before 9:00am** the morning you are planning to come to lunch and order a school lunch. This way we are sure to have enough food for everyone. Then stop in the office to sign in and pick up a VISITOR badge before joining your child for lunch.

Adult lunches may be scanned from your child's lunch account or paid for in the main office. ***If you choose to pay with cash for your lunch we ask that you have the exact change.*** Thanks so much for your help. We hope to see you at lunch!

When coming for lunch, we do ask that you decide to either eat school lunch or bring a sack lunch from home. **Please do not buy lunch at a fast food restaurant such as McDonald's or Burger King to bring to school. Do not send pop to school.**
