Kindergarten 2019-20

We have started compiling our list of kindergarten students for the 2019–20 school year! If you have a child that will be starting kindergarten in the 2019–20 school year or have a friend or neighbor with a first child starting kindergarten in the fall, please ask them to call Pam (447–3270) as soon as possible, to be added to our growing kindergarten list.

Our kindergarten parent orientation meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 29, at 6:00 PM. This meeting is for <u>PARENTS ONLY</u>. Students will visit their classrooms in August. Paperwork may be dropped off beginning at 5:45.

Children must be 5 years old by September 15, 2019 to enter school in the fall. Verification of birth (hospital certificate, baptism certificate, or certified birth certificate) must be presented on or before school registration in August. These documents may be presented during registration at the orientation meeting in February.

Parents should attend the orientation meeting in the building assigned to their home address. If a request for an Attendance Exception Request (AER) to a different building is desired; parents should still attend their assigned building's orientation. Anyone who has questions regarding the boundaries of the elementary attendance areas may call any of the secretaries at the elementary buildings.

Attendance Procedures

- If your student will be absent or arriving late, parent are asked to call the Indian Creek attendance line (447-3272) by 8:00 AM. Please be sure to state your students name, the homeroom teacher and the reason for their absence. If you child is ill please give a short description of the illness (for state health reporting).
- If your student will be arriving late, please indicate their lunch choice either hot, alternate, Lion Cub, or cold lunch.
- If your student will be leaving early, please call the attendance line at 447-3272 and let us know who will be picking up your student and the time he/she will be leaving.
- We will not call students to the office until you arrive, please allow a few extra minutes when picking up your student.



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"Inclement Weather" Policy

It's that time of year when we need to give some thought to weather-related late arrivals and early dismissals. If severe weather, including fog, forces a late arrival or the closing of school for the entire day, announcements will be made on local radio and television stations, starting by at least 6:30 a.m. Announcements can also be accessed on the Linn-Mar website at www.linnmar.k12.ia.us, or online at KGAN.com or KCRG.com. You can choose to receive notification of an early dismissal/late arrival by Twitter or Facebook, just go to the Linn-Mar website and click on the corresponding icons (at the bottom of the page) to sign up for notification via these social media sites, including the option to have text messages sent directly to your cell phone. You may also get a text notification from KCRG; just sign up on their web sites.

Please do not call the school. If a late arrival is declared, school will start at 10:00 a.m. and students may enter the building at 9:45 a.m., with bus pickups occurring two hours later than usual. For example, if the bus usually picks up your child at 7:24 in the morning, he/she will be picked up at 9:24 a.m. on a late arrival day. Early dismissals are announced on the local radio and television stations as well. If the weather seems threatening, keep in mind that an early dismissal is possible and listen for news announcements on your radio or television. Please discuss with your child where he/she is supposed to go in the event of an early dismissal. Unless we have been notified by a parent or guardian, we have them go home in their usual way. Thank you!



Attendance Exception Requests for 2019-2020 due March 1

Parents/Guardians of Linn-Mar resident students wishing to attend a Linn-Mar school outside their assigned attendance center area must submit their annual letter for an attendance exception request in writing by March 1. Letters may be mailed to Nathan Wear, Associate Superintendent, 2999 North Tenth Street, Marion, IA 52302. Requests will be evaluated after an assessment of classroom seat space is made. Requests are **NOT** guaranteed from year to year. Interested parents should be aware that district transportation is <u>NOT</u> available to students receiving approval for an attendance center request.



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
Snowy Weather and the Playground





If there is snow on the ground, these are the guidelines we will be using at Indian Creek for the playground:


- 1. Children without snow boots (boots that are not worn all day long) will be asked to play on the shoveled areas of the playground only.

- 3. Children with snow boots, snow pants/snow suits, and mittens/gloves will be allowed to play in the snow.



Notes from the Health Office



- •If your child contracts a communicable illness, such as strep throat, pink eye, etc., please call Mrs. Rosendale, our health assistant, at 447-3273. She will distribute informational notes to the other students in your child's classroom. Then, teachers and classmates can take additional measures to reduce the spread of these illnesses. In the case of a communicable illness, please wait 24 hours after the start of antibiotic treatment before sending your child back to school.
- •Since the cold and flu season is upon us, please do not send your child to school if they are ill. Students who have been ill should not return to school until they have been fever, vomit, and diarrhea free for 24 hours.
- •If a student needs to take cough drops during the school day, you may send cough drops from home. Our health assistant can give students cough drops with written permission from parents. A doctor's signature is not required. Students should bring cough drops to the health office; they should not be taken to the classroom. Cough drops will be labeled with the student's name and will be kept in the health office. An entry will be made in our health log every time a student is given a cough drop.
- •A physician's order (which can be faxed to the school office at 373-9233) <u>and</u> written parental permission is required for over-the-counter medications to be given to students at school. All medications will be distributed through the health office.
- •Students in elementary school are allowed to refrain from participation in outdoor recess or physical education classes for health reasons for up to three (3) consecutive school days with a written request from the parent or guardian. A physician's note, explaining the nature of the student's limitation and recommended length of non-participation, shall be requested after the third excused day.
- •Emphasize the importance of hand washing to your child/ren. Washing hands after using the restroom, sneezing, coughing, blowing your nose, and before eating can help keep us healthy.
