\*\*Seniors: Make sure you fill out the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) ASAP. We encourage ALL families with students heading to college to fill this out regardless of financial situation. This is the only way to be eligible for federal aid to help pay for colleges and many colleges require it to be filled out for scholarships. If all you receive is loans and don't want them, you can decline aid! It's better to have the form filled out and not need it, than to not have it filled out at all and need it!

\*\*Seniors: Just a reminder that all transcript requests to colleges and teacher recommendation letters are done through Family Connection. If you need help with this process stop in the College/Career Center or see your School Counselor.

### **Parking 18-19**

\*\*Students who have parking tags to park on campus MUST advise Mrs. Sturenfeldt in the 11/12 Office of any changes of vehicle information including new license plates. Vehicles not registered to park on campus will be ticketed.

Students must park in their designated parking lots. The North parking lot is set up for students and staff to have designated areas to park. The South parking lot is blended parking which means student and staff share the parking lot together. Students need to have their parking tags displayed at all times.

Parking Lot Reminder! Students are not allowed to park in the visitor or staff parking areas. during school hours. This is a parking violation and you will receive a parking fine of \$25.00.

Park in your designated lot with your parking tag displayed to avoid being ticketed.

Students who drive their moped to school need to park on the designated area in the South Lot. Please register your moped before driving it on campus. Students who have the privilege of parking on campus please remember to follow the Linn-Mar parking guidelines to avoid getting a parking fine:

- Park in your designated parking lot.
- Always have your parking tag displayed in your vehicle.
- Register any car you drive on campus to the 11th/12th office. •

Parking tags are not transferable.

- Do NOT parking in staff, visitors or handicap areas.
- Parking fines costs \$25.00 and must be paid within 14 days.
- Receiving 3 parking fines will result in the loss of your parking tag for the school year. •
- Students are NOT allowed to park at Excelsior Middle School.
- Students are NOT allowed to park in the apartment lots across the street.
- Students parking on the street, please do not block driveways or fire hydrants or you will get ticketed by the Marion Police.
- The East Lot is for South Lot overflow parking only.

Students must park in their designated parking lots. The North parking lot is set up for students and staff to have designated areas to park.
