
How to Teach PHONE NUMBERS

- -Have your child practice "dialing" important phone numbers



Phone Number Cover Up

Materials: A Phone Number Cover Up game board for each player, tokens (7 per player), 2 dice, erasable markers

Objective: To be the first person to cover up all the numbers your board.

To Play:

- 1. Players write their phone numbers on their boards with erasable markers, one number per space.
- 2. Players decide who will go first.
- 3. Players take turns rolling the dice and adding or subtracting the two numbers rolled and covering up that number on their board. Only one number can be covered up per turn. If the number is already covered up, the player's turn is over.
- 4. The game ends when every number on one player's board is covered. That player is the winner.
- 5. Players erase their boards when finished playing the game.
