


- Coronavirus (COVID-19) is a contagious virus that can be passed from one person to another by...

- Touching a surface infected with the virus and then touching your eyes, nose or mouth


## Coronavirus Explained by a Superhero





What can we do to help prevent the spread of Covid-19?

- Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- Use hand sanitizer when you can't wash your hands
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow
- Social distance (6ft) whenever possible
- Avoid touching your face with unwashed hands
- Wear your mask (unless you are unable to for medical reasons)
- Stay home if you are feeling sick and avoid being around others who are sick



- ❖ It is important to leave our masks on when we are in the school building and on the school bus.
- Masks help prevent the spread of germs.
- Masks should cover both our nose and mouths.
- ❖ Your mask should remain on your face anytime you are in the building unless you are eating. Your mask can come off when you are outside but try to keep a safe distance when interacting with peers.
