## **COVID Information/Questions for School**

When calling your child out for illness please have the following information ready. Due to COVID concerns will be asking and needing a little more information than we have in the past.

### Does your student have a fever?

- If fever is 100.0F or greater without fever reducers student must stay home.

### Do any family members have COVID or symptoms of COVID at this time?

### Does you child have any of the following symptoms?

- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- New cough
- New loss of taste or smell
- Headache
- Diarrhea
- Nausea/vomiting
- Muscle/body aches
- Sore throat
- Fatigue/lethargy
- Rash
- Congestion/runny nose
- If your student has two or more of possible COVID symptoms we are requiring that he or she remain at home for 10 days or be tested for COVID or another illness.

## Students Arriving Late and Leaving Early

Bringing you child to school late or picking your child up early will look different this year.

If you are bringing your child to school late you will need to pull into the parking lot off Indian Creek Road and park in a parking space and call the Indian Creek office. Once you reach someone in the office, they will send a staff member out to walk your child into the building.

If you have to pick your student up early for an appointment, going out of town, or whatever the case maybe you will need to pull into the parking lot off of Indian Creek Road and park in a parking space and call the Indian Creek office (319.447.3270 or 319.447.3272). Once you reach someone in the office please provide a description of your vehicle and location as to where you are parked. The office staff will call your child from his or her class and walk him or her to your vehicle. Please allow for extra time when picking up your child early from school. Please note we will not be able to call students from class and walk them out until you are parked in the parking lot. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

# Crossing Guard Safety

Please help us keep our crossing guards and students safe! Morning crossing at the corner of Indian Creek Road and 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue is a very busy time. Please be sure to watch for directions from our crossing guards while you are at the intersection. A few points to remember. All vehicles must stop once the crossing guard or pedestrian steps into the cross walk and must remained stopped until the crossing guard and or pedestrian has safely crossed the street and is no longer in the cross walk. Making a quick right-hand turn is not ever allowed while the crossing guard or pedestrian is still in the cross walk.

# Front Parking Lot Procedures



To allow our school busses the entire area in front of our school to drop students off and be able to turn the busses around. We need to keep this area open and free of car traffic for our busses from 8:00 AM until 8:30 AM. Parents who will be dropping off children at Hand in Hand will need to have them dropped off by 8:00 AM. Dismissal is another challenge. We have 4 busses to load after school and will need to have the entire parking lot cleared by 2:45 in order to stage the busses and load our student safely on the busses. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in keeping all of our Indian Creek students, parents, volunteers, and visitors safe.

### Morning Drop Off Procedure:

Enter the back parking lot off of 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Pull into lane 5, next to the sidewalk, and as far forward as possible. If you are the first vehicle you will park just beyond the corner of the gym and **wait for an on-duty staff member** to assist your student. Students will exit the vehicle on the passenger's side of the vehicle. *Drivers: please <u>REMAIN</u> in your vehicle* and watch for direction from staff on duty. If Lane 5 is full pull behind the vehicles in the lane forming a U shape (see the arrows above) holding pattern. Lane 5 will fill as vehicles exit the lane. All vehicles need to <u>stay in the line</u> (do not pull out and around the vehicles in front of you) following the vehicle in front of them to the end of the lane where vehicles will turn left, staying along the edge of the parking lot back to the 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue driveway.

### Afternoon Pick Up Procedure:

Notice we have five lanes designated for pick up lanes. Lane 1 and 2 are in between the first and second row of the parked cars and lanes 3, 4 and 5 are located between the parking lot and the sidewalk next to the school. Enter the back parking lot off of 29<sup>th</sup> Avenue filling lanes 1 and 2 first, then lanes 3 and 4. Lane 5 is reserved for the daycare busses and vans. The first vehicle should pull up as far as possible in the lane. If the lanes are full vehicles should form a U shape (see the arrows above) holding pattern and wait for instructions to be given by the staff on duty. Indian Creek staff will use walkie-talkies to communicate. Staff will identify drivers and call for students. Students will walk down the passenger side of each lane to load vehicles and follow instructions given by the staff on duty. *Drivers: Please <u>REMAIN</u> in your vehicles.* If your student has not been loaded and the lane is ready to exit please pull forward and park on the re-load area (located on the north end) of the lot. A staff member will escort your student to your vehicle. Once your child(ren) have been loaded please <u>stay in the line</u> (do not pull out and around the vehicles in front of you) and follow the car in front of you to exit the parking lot.

Thank you to all of our families for following these procedures and keeping our students, staff, and families safe during these very busy times of the day.
